MAY 2023 CHAPTER LUNCHEON

Catalyzing Economic Growth Through Tactical Urbanism

Wednesday, May 17 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. Maggiano's Little Italy

In June 2020, at the height of the pandemic and in the wake of civil unrest, a group of architects, planners, and designers came together with the goal of helping communities on the city's South and West sides re-open during challenging times. The result was two public interventions – 75th Street Boardwalk and POPCourts!. The success of these two projects led to the Public Outdoor Plazas (POP) Program, along with ten additional plazas, which sought to activate vacant lots on commercial corridors through Tactical Urbanism.

Tactical Urbanism (n): An approach to neighborhood building that uses short-term, low-cost, and scalable interventions to catalyze long-term change.

The Mayor's Office and Department of Planning and Development (DPD) are developing the next iteration of the POP Program with a focus on vacant storefronts. The goal is to use the same Tactical Urbanism strategies to catalyze economic growth along these corridors.

The success of the POP Program and its expansion suggest that tactical urbanism could be employed in

Congratulations to LAI-Ely chapter member Katanya Raby who was recently promoted to Vice President of Planning and Development at the Far South CDC.

Raby started at Far South CDC as the Director of Planning in 2021 and she immediately enhanced the department with the development of the 21,780 square foot POP! Heights Park. This development is the first public outdoor park along South Halsted in Roseland in more than 50 years. Additionally, through Raby's previous work with the City of Chicago Mayor's Office, she paved the way for Far South CDC to receive its first nine percent Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) allocation to build 286 units of mixed-income housing in East Morgan Park.

In her new role, Raby is leading the way for the Far South CDC's expansion into large-scale real estate development and regional planning with its "Bringing Communities Back Initiative" (BCBI), which seeks to redevelop more than one million square feet of vacant and abandoned properties on Chicago's far south side and south suburban Cook County.
